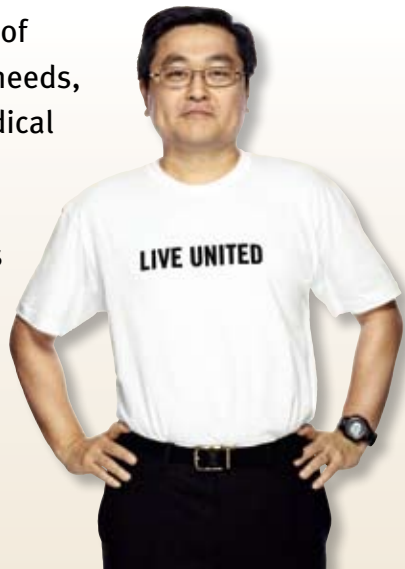
Orange County United Way is about building self-sufficient lives for the health of our community.

United Way supports programs for children and youth to prepare them academically, socially and emotionally to grow to be independent adults. The future of our children begins with their education and we are committed to supporting strategies that enable our children to reach their full potential.

Financial Stability

United Way supports financial education and job development programs that allow individuals to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to attain financial independence.
